What is Quizizz?

Students focus on accuracy, not speed, and progress at their own pace.

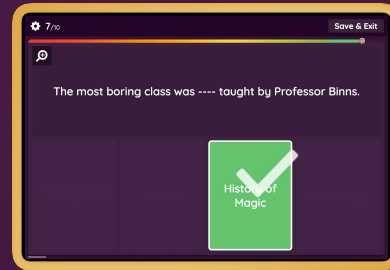
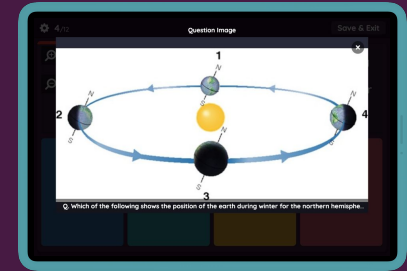
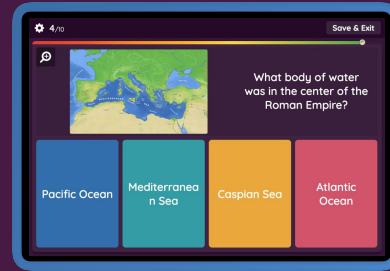


Better Data & Feedback

Set a Due Date

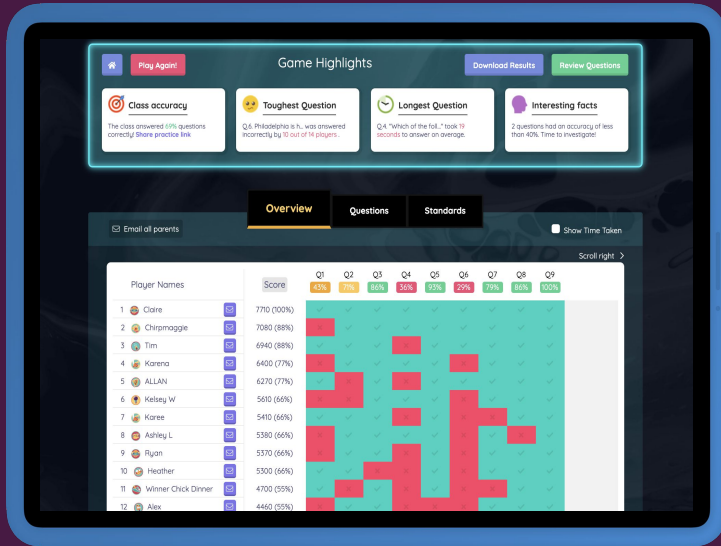
Assign a quiz and students complete it any time before the due date.



How To Create a Quiz or Lesson


First, be sure to create your **QUIZZZ** account @ <https://quizizz.com>

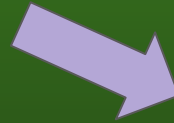

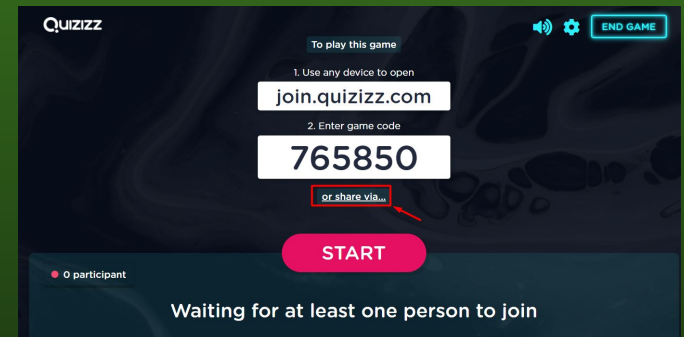
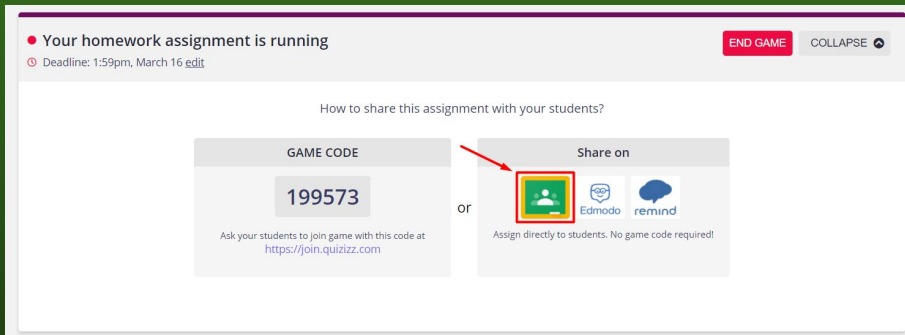
When you click on the add slides, you can add interactive elements such as have such as video, audio, or images. You can import questions, or create new ones here.

Important FYI's;

- 1) Naming and saving your lesson or quiz
- 2) Syncing to Google Classroom
- 3) Copying game link to LMS (not syncing)
- 4) What students will receive in Google Classroom or LMS
- 5) Reports
- 6) Syncing app to LMS
- 7) Important Pro Tip regarding student email account

Once Finished Publish and Sync to Google Classroom

- 1) Click Publish
- 2) Choose **Live** or **Homework** game on your dashboard.
- 3) Select the **Classroom Share** button (for Homework), or copy came code link.
The game link can be shared through LMS, or email as a link if needed.
- 4) Click **Share via** button (for Live game) as shown in images below.





Instructions for Completion of Assignment Details: You will be prompted, but here are some steps to be aware of ...


- 1) Click on the Google Classroom share button, you will be prompted to complete the following details:
 - **Course:** Select the class that you wish to assign the quiz to.
 - **Assignment title:** Enter assignment title.
 - **Assignment description:** Enter quiz description if any.
- 2) For a Homework game, you can also schedule the assignment.
- 3) Click 'Change' to set the date that Google Classroom will send this out.

**** With Distance learning, schedule the end date for 30 days or the assignment will expire. This is a hassle! ****

Student Reports

STUDENTS CLICK LINK YOU PROVIDE: they will be prompted to **login with their Google accounts.**

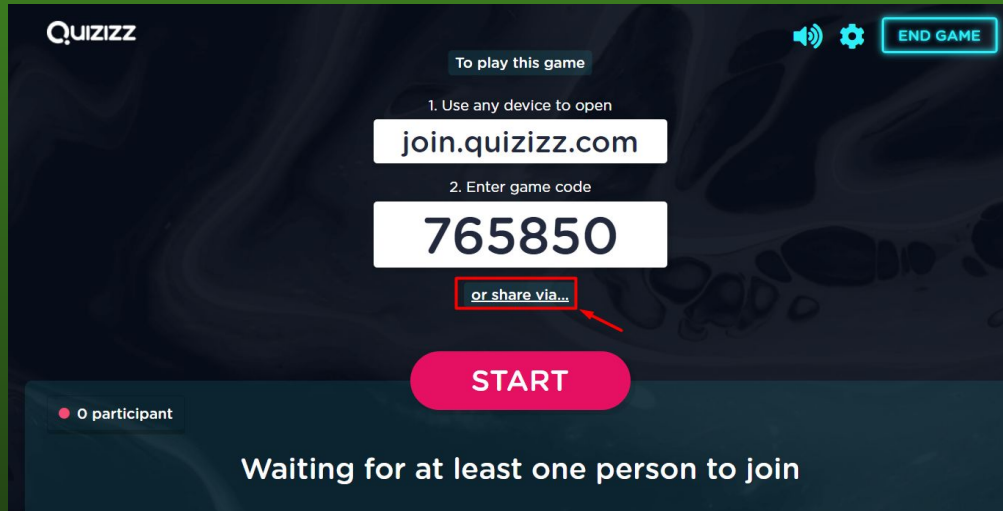
They can choose any nickname for the leaderboard. - you have access to both

In the reports screen, you'll see their **actual name from their Google account**, as well as the name they entered (in brackets). Your students' data will also automatically be updated in your Google Classroom account.

The site indicates that it may take 24 hours for reports to load after the expiration date, giving you time to extend the game. To avoid this, click the **END GAME** date when scheduling.

How To Sync to LMS


Every LMS has a help section where you can determine if Quizizz can be linked and created through your LMS, or you can ask your systems administrator if this is possible. If not, through your LMS, you can simple add the game link.



PRO TIP

To keep reports and classes together, it is helpful to use Google Classroom. You can assign the Quizizz assignments in Google Classroom and on the LMS.

Students will be directed to the same link, and your reports will be accessible in Quizizz for all students

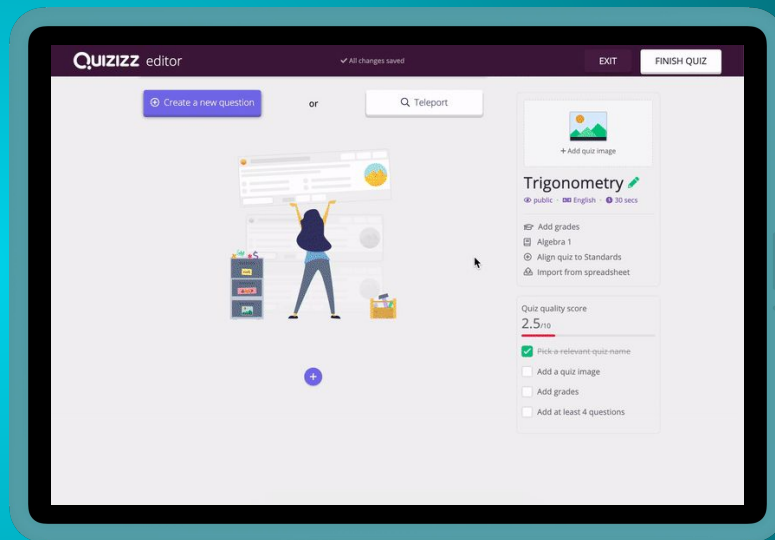

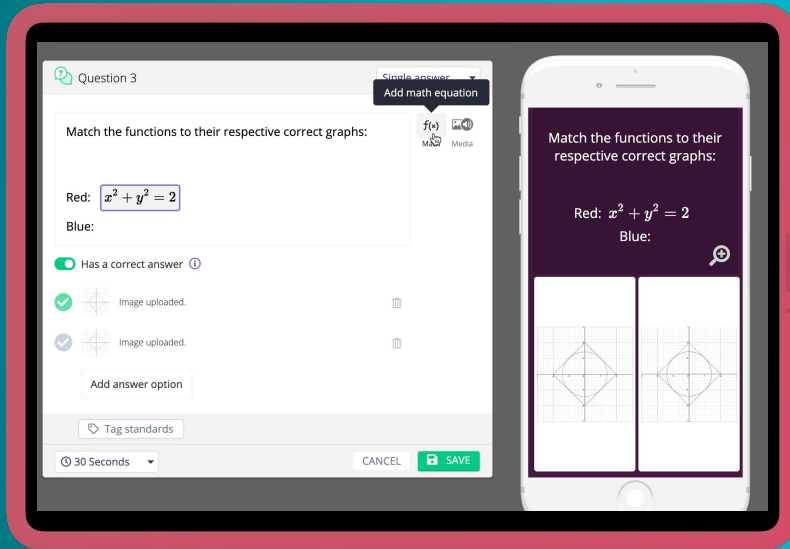


Using The Quizizz Library

Using the Read Aloud setting on student devices

Our Read Aloud feature reads out questions and answer options for students using Chromebooks, laptops, desktops, and mobile devices.

To turn on Read Aloud, open the game settings menu on the student device. Several different languages are supported and if students change their language settings, the Read Aloud feature automatically adjusts the pronunciation to match the selected language.

This feature is especially useful for younger students, language learners and those with special needs.

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ECE, ELL, Dyslexia, Auditory Learners;

From their devices, students can click on game settings menus in the app and turn on READ ALOUD.

Students can also select other languages.



With the new symbols support, you can use the Quizzizz Creator to create equations, add latin/greek symbols, foreign language characters, and even Emojis.

To add a symbol to a question, click on the "Add symbol" button in the menu as shown in the image below (Click the text field to view the menu bar).

How are Power-ups scored? [?](#)

Power-ups are additional abilities that are applied on questions to improve the chances of getting a higher score. They are not scored separately and do not impact overall accuracy scores. Accuracy is calculated purely on the percentage of correct responses, and not on points. You can easily view the accuracy score for your students through our reports that highlight points and accuracy separately.

While power-ups may influence student ranking on the leader-board, it does not impact their accuracy score.
